



3. Project Background and Project Location



Who is the Broward MPO?

- A federally chartered entity responsible for transportation decision making in the Broward region
 - Influence the expenditure of federal and state transportation funds at the regional level
- MPO Board
 - 31 municipalities
 - Broward County
 - Broward County School Board
 - South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (Tri-Rail)
- Develop plans, conduct studies, establish initiatives and programs

To collaboratively plan, prioritize, and fund the delivery of diverse transportation options.

Cypress Creek Mobility Hub



- Study Area ½-mile circle around the Cypress Creek Tri-Rail Station
- Partners: Broward MPO, FDOT, SFRTA, Broward County, City of Fort Lauderdale, City of Oakland Park, Envision Uptown


- Mobility Hubs: Transit-access points with frequent transit service and opportunities for development/ redevelopment.
- Master Plan goal: Plan efficient transportation connections that will spur continued growth and development, enhance walkability, and promote the use of multiple modes of transportation within this Mobility Hub.
- Broward MPO formally accepted the Master Plan recommendations in 2016.
- FDOT leading the implementation of streetscape improvements to improve multimodal connections to transit.





Background

- Increase capacity and improve traffic operations and safety
- Design phase began in July 2018
- The project was split into 5 segments for design and construction (Segments 2, 3, 4, 5, 7)
- Segment 5 is currently at 30% design stage and is the subject of this meeting
- Segment 5 has State and Local Funding

- New sidewalk along both sides




Cypress Creek Road from Powerline Road to SFRTA Railroad


















Segment 5 Proposed Streetscape

Segment 5 Benefits

Mobility Hub at Cypress Creek Road



- Improved connectivity to Tri-Rail station and future transit-oriented development
- Increases capacity by extending left turn lanes from EB Cypress Creek Rd to NB N Andrews Ave
- Shared use path along Cypress Creek Rd will provide a designated pathway for pedestrians and bicyclists physically separated from vehicular lanes
- New sidewalk along both sides of N Andrews Way and new sidewalk and shared use path along NW 59th Court



5. Temporary Traffic Control Plan



Temporary Traffic Control Plan

- Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction to the community.
- Maintain existing number of lanes during peak hours
- Lane closures to perform pavement resurfacing and sidewalk construction
- Pedestrian detours will be provided to maintain connectivity
- Access to all properties along the project will be maintained



6. Project Schedule and Cost



Segment 5 Schedule/Cost

Mobility Hub at Cypress Creek Road



- Currently in design
 - Initial (30%)
- Design Completion Fall 2022
- Construction Start Date Spring 2023
- Estimated Construction Cost \$4.8 million


